

There is an ongoing toxic drug poisoning crisis and this is causing hundreds of people in the Cowichan Valley to suffer overdoses each year.

Sadly, dozens of people do not survive.

* to April 29, 2021




The Cowichan Valley Wellness and Recovery Centre is needed to save lives and support people's health and well-being.

- Substance use disorder is a chronic disease that requires specialized treatment.
- With proper treatment and support, recovery from substance use disorder is possible.


