



Yakimovich Wellness Centre – COVID-19 Protocols for In-Person attendances

The YWC has been closed to in-person sessions since March 2020. The Centre has opened its doors to offer in-person health education sessions and to other user groups' in February 2022. Due to the most recent PHO orders (February 16th, 2022) the Yakimovich Wellness Centre can seat at full capacity, but everyone must use hand sanitizer at entry and wear a medical grade mask at all times in the Centre.

Upon entering the Hillside Seniors Health Centre – registered participants will be greeted by a door ambassador – who will:

- a. ask you a series of COVID related questions,
- b. ask you to use hand sanitizer,
- c. take your temperature and,
- d. provide you with a medical grade mask.

Once this is complete, you will walk to the entrance of the Yakimovich Wellness Centre

All highly touched surfaces will be cleaned before and after each session.

Yakimovich Wellness Centre will be following the guidelines provided by the Public Health Order, BC Government - they are as follows:

- 2.) Show proof of vaccine and show one piece of government identification with a photo (the name on your proof of vaccine must match the name on your identification).
- 3.) Once inside the YWC:
 - a. Must wear the medical grade mask provided to you at the door at all times
 - b. Choose a seat and stay in your seat
 - c. Please limit congregating with each other inside the Centre – congregating is preferred to be done outside the doors of the Hillside Seniors Health Centre
