When you visit the health unit or clinic, please help stop the spread of germs by:

- Informing the staff that you are not well
- Wearing a mask to protect staff and others if an appointment cannot be rescheduled
- Covering your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze
- Coughing or sneezing into your sleeve (crook of your arm)...not your hand
- Using a tissue and placing used tissues into a waste basket
- Cleaning your hands after coughing or sneezing with one or two squirts of alcohol-based hand cleaner
- Remembering to use alcohol-based hand cleaner before putting your mask on and after taking your mask off
- Phoning in first if sick to determine whether your appointment can be changed
