We are pleased to inform you that, due to increased capacity and decreased Echo procedure waitlists we are able to open up booking privileges for the booking of **Exercise Stress Echocardiograms** to **General Practitioners**. Previously, only Cardiologists, Internists and a few other Specialists could order a Stress Echo. However we are increasing the eligibility to stress echo since there is a shortage of isotopes and this might expedite the diagnosis of a patient.

Criteria for GP patients for Stress Echo:

 Must have had a non-diagnostic treadmill test within the past 12 months, completing at least 6 minutes on an Exercise Stress Test, reaching a Heart Rate of greater than or equal to 120 bpm AND be stratified, as "low risk" for coronary artery disease

OR

2. Low risk based on patient ≤ 40 y.o. with atypical chest pain. This group may be referred directly for Stress Echo without a previous treadmill test.

The ordering Physician is responsible to inform the patient of prep requirements. Please refer to the attached "Echocardiogram Patient Information" handout for details on preparation requirements for Echo procedures. **Required documentation:** A referral letter and if applicable, results of ECG treadmill test must accompany the Echo procedure booking form. If Stress Echo is for a low risk patient without a previous treadmill test, then an accompanying ECG is required.

*Please note: This procedure does not include a Cardiology consultation
