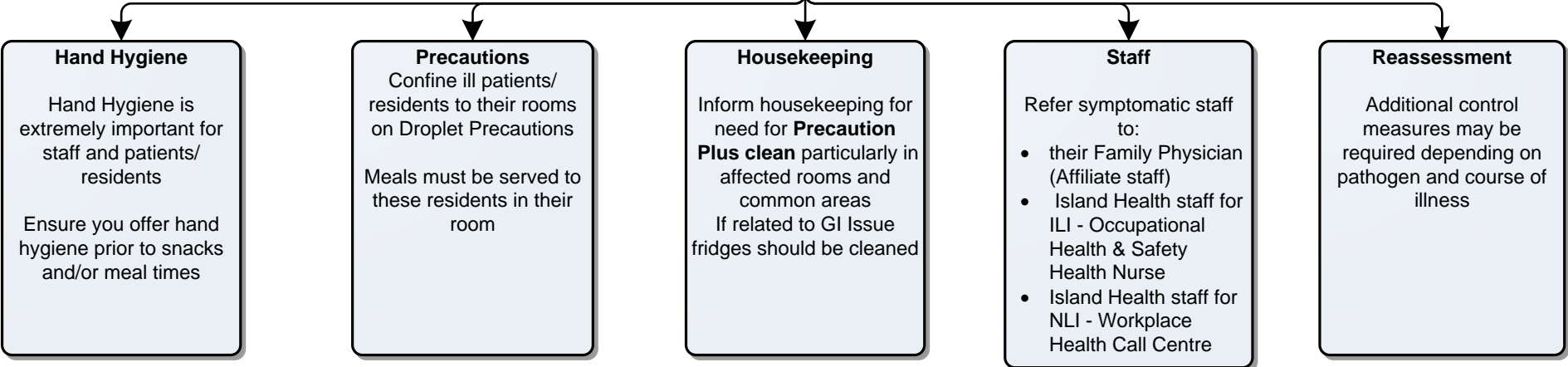


Outbreak Restrictions Not Imposed for Acute Care/Residential/Congregate Living

Continue DROPLET Precautions for ill patients/residents/clients and exposed roommates

ACTIONS



Hand Hygiene

Hand Hygiene is extremely important for staff and patients/residents

Ensure you offer hand hygiene prior to snacks and/or meal times

Precautions

Confine ill patients/residents to their rooms on Droplet Precautions

Meals must be served to these residents in their room

Housekeeping

Inform housekeeping for need for **Precaution Plus clean** particularly in affected rooms and common areas

If related to GI Issue fridges should be cleaned

Staff

Refer symptomatic staff to:

- their Family Physician (Affiliate staff)
- Island Health staff for ILI - Occupational Health & Safety Health Nurse
- Island Health staff for NLI - Workplace Health Call Centre

Reassessment

Additional control measures may be required depending on pathogen and course of illness

PLEASE NOTE:

- For affiliated facilities follow up with the CD Nurse in conjunction with MHO
- For Island health facilities follow up with IPAC and MM

Congregate Living areas include: Affiliates, Mental Health and Addictions, Acute Rehab & Alternative Level of Care Units with dining and activity rooms
