Point of Care Testing (POCT) - ACCU-CHEK® Performa Quick Reference Guide

Applies to:	All Island Health Residential and Long Term Care employees and affiliates members who perform blood glucose monitoring at the point of care using the ACCU-CHEK® Performa meter.
Purpose:	To complete the required education and confirm your competency to use ACCU-CHEK® Performa.

Education and Competency Requirements

- Education is mandatory before using the device.
- Access to the device is granted only once education is completed and competency is confirmed.

Completing Education and Competency Requirements

1. Click the [ACCU-CHEK® Performa Blood Glucose Meter](#) course.
 - You'll be directed to the Learning Management System login page.
2. Log on to the Learning Management System and complete the lesson and quiz.
 - A Record of Completion will be generated under your training history in your CCRS account.
1. Print and keep a copy of your Record of Completion from CCRS.
2. Print and keep a copy of the Competency Checklist from the course.
3. Submit your Record of Completion to your supervisor/educator.
4. Complete the Competency Checklist with your supervisor/educator to confirm your competency.
