# **Cleaning and Disinfecting the Performa Meter**

**Purpose:** This procedure describes the indications and steps for cleaning and disinfecting the Performa meter.

**Note**: VIHA Infection Prevention and Control Manual (2011) stipulates all multi-use equipment must be cleaned between patients/residents (Refer to VIHA Infection Control Manual).

 Glucose meters must be cleaned after each use if used for multiple patients

#### **Definitions:**

**Cleaning** is the physical removal of dirt and organic matter (80%). Cleaning is an essential component of best practice. Use *one* wipe to clean.

**Disinfection** is the removal and destruction of most pathogens by the use of friction (cleaning) and use of a disinfectant. Use *two* wipes to disinfect.

**Product:** VIHA/Meter Manufacturer approved cleaning/disinfecting product:

 Accelerated Hydrogen Peroxide 0.5% - Accel wipes VIHA Stores Meditech Order #0031010

### Procedure A: Cleaning the Performa glucose meter

	ACTION	Related Documents Title Number
1	Determine if meter, requires cleaning:     Cleaning is performed after each use when used for multiple patients	
2	Wear clean gloves	
3	Gather supplies: Meter, and Accel wipes (ensure expiry date has not been exceeded)	
4	Squeeze out excess moisture from wipe before applying to surface	
5	Place meter to be cleaned on a level surface and wipe entire exterior  • Ensure moisture does not enter device through open ports	
6	Discard wipe	
7	Allow surface to remain wet for 3 minutes	
8	Ensure surface is thoroughly dry	
9	Remove gloves and discard or continue with disinfecting procedure if indicated	

## Procedure B: Disinfecting the Performa glucose meter

	ACTION	
1	Determine if meter requires disinfecting: <ul> <li>Surface is soiled with blood</li> <li>Meter has been exposed to an individual who requires additional precautions to be taken</li> <li>Meter has been exposed to an infectious agent</li> <li>Glucose meter requires disinfecting routinely every 7 days</li> </ul>	
2	Wear gloves	
3	Follow steps 3 – 8 of Procedure A (cleaning) to clean surface of meter	
4	Repeat steps 3 – 8 with a new Accel wipe allowing the surface to remain wet for an additional 3 minutes to allow for disinfection	
5	Remove gloves and perform hand hygiene
