

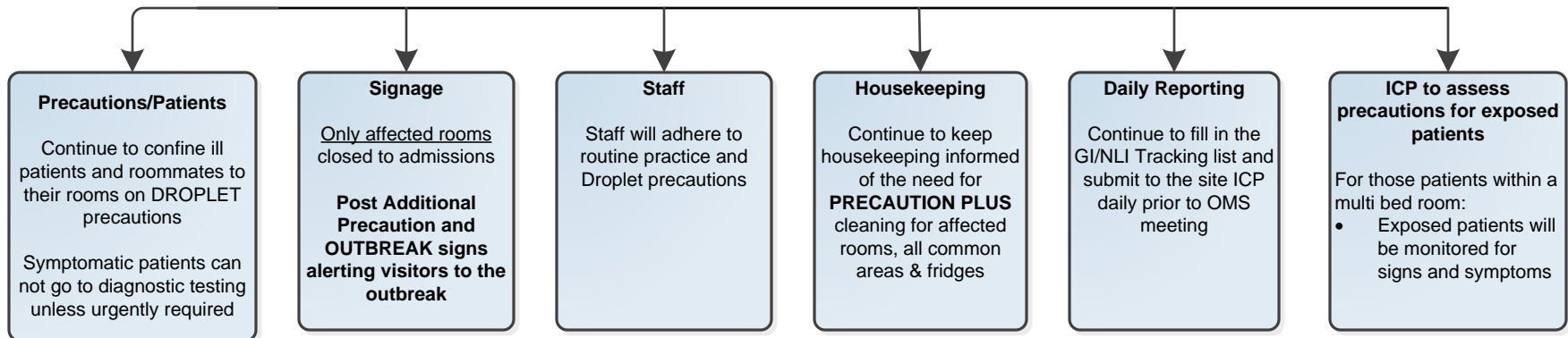
Gastro Outbreak caused by Norovirus or Other Pathogens Restrictions Imposed in Acute Care

GI/NLI has been confirmed by the IPAC program

Continue DROPLET precautions for symptomatic patients and for roommates

Start Outbreak Meeting
Structure & Actions to follow during GI/NLI Outbreaks

Droplet precautions = Gowns, gloves and surgical grade masks (120 mmHg) with visors/eye protection are required if working within 2 metres (6 feet) of symptomatic patients



Please Note: A GI/NLI outbreak identified in any acute care facility will only be declared over by an IPAC with MM. GI/NLI outbreaks will be declared over either:

- 4 days from the start of symptoms in the last patient
- 2 days after the start of symptoms in a staff member

This time can be extended but not shortened by IPAC with MM
