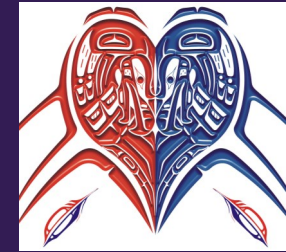

To support culturally appropriate care for Aboriginal patients, Island Health is pleased to connect you with a Care Transition Liaison Nurse upon request. Please let us know how we can help make your hospital visit more comfortable.

Patients, family and friends can request a referral to the Care Transition Liaison Nurse before or during a hospital stay.

Care Transition Liaison Nurse can help by:

- ◆ Supporting patients and families while in hospital and explaining health care information
- ◆ Identifying eligibility and access to non-insured health benefits
- ◆ Assist in patient care planning with the multidisciplinary team at Tofino General Hospital and in collaboration with health professionals in the community including the Nuuchah-Nulth Tribal Council
- ◆ Working with hospital staff, patients, family and community to support clear communication and discharge planning

Things to know:

- ◆ Please bring your BC Care Card and Status Card.
- ◆ Check with your Band and/or Patient Travel Clerk as soon as possible to see if you are eligible for travel assistance or support for meals and accommodation.
- ◆ Island Health's Aboriginal Health program does not have the ability to provide any financial assistance.
- ◆ For those who qualify, assistance may be available from their Band or Health Canada (First Nations Health Authority).

We respect your privacy and confidentiality

- ◆ Island Health takes measures to ensure that your personal information is treated in a confidential manner according to the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act and will only share the necessary and relevant information for the purposes of your ongoing care and services.
- ◆ Health care professionals have a responsibility to report risks to the health or safety of patients or others.

You have the right to:

- ◆ Know that your information is kept confidential
- ◆ Make a complaint and know that you will still get care and be treated fairly
- ◆ Say yes or no to services
- ◆ Be treated in a safe and respectful way
