### Launch of the monthly Resident Newsletter

### Moving date

The Summit will have underground parking with 94 spaces. A committee is working on ways to best allocate parking for visitors, staff, physicians and volunteers.

The Summit is also near several BC Transit routes. Currently two bus lines stop directly in front of The Summit: #4 UVic/Downtown and #9 Royal Oak/UVic.

### Naming guidelines:


- A short name just 2 or 3 syllables
