Vancouver Island Facilities

CAMPBELL RIVER HOSPITAL, Campbell River

(25,500 emergency visits/year)

Capacity: 14 stretchers and 6 chairs (IV therapy, fast track), 2 large trauma/resuscitation rooms, 2 rapid assessment rooms, 2 lockable observation room, 8 monitors, 1 EENT and 1 gynecology room, 2 negative pressure room, a crisis team (7 days/week) and sexual assault services.



NORTH ISLAND HOSPITAL COMOX VALLEY, Courtenay (29,500 emergency visits/year)

Capacity: 16 stretchers and 6 chairs (IV therapy, fast track), 2 large trauma/resuscitation rooms, 2 rapid assessment rooms, 1 lockable observation room, 8 monitors, 1 EENT and 1 gynecology room, 2 negative pressure room, Primary Care Link Coordinator and sexual assault services.

COWICHAN DISTRICT HOSPITAL, Duncan (30,000 emergency visits/year)

Capacity: 17 stretchers including a two bay trauma room, five monitored beds, five telemetry capable beds, one EENT room, one pediatric room, one gynecological room, one psychiatric room, one suture room, fast track chair area, an on-call sexual assault team and negative pressure room.

NANAIMO REGIONAL GENERAL HOSPITAL, Nanaimo (57,000 emergency visits/year)

Capacity: 24 stretchers, two bed trauma/resuscitation room, 30 monitor spaces, psychiatric emergency service room, included in the 24 rooms, one gynecology room, one EENT room, two negative pressure rooms, an ambulatory area and sexual assault on-call system. This facility is the regional centre for Trauma, Cardiac, Respiratory, General Surgery, Orthopedics, Obstetrics and Gynecology, Pediatrics, Rehabilitation, Oncology and Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Services.

ROYAL JUBILEE HOSPITAL, Victoria (46,000 emergency visits/year)

Capacity: 25 stretchers including a two bay resuscitation room, 10 monitors, two isolation rooms, two suture rooms, hemodialysis capability, one negative pressure room, one gynecology room, one EENT room, one casting room, seven fast track stretchers and a separate psychiatric emergency service. This facility is the tertiary centre for Cardiac, Respiratory, Renal, Psychiatric, Vascular and Oncology services, located in the Diagnostic & Treatment Centre.

VICTORIA GENERAL HOSPITAL, Victoria

(60,000 emergency visits/year, 25% are pediatrics)

Capacity: 20 stretchers plus a two bay adult Trauma/resuscitation room, one pediatric trauma/resuscitation room and a decontamination room. Four of these rooms are negative pressure capable and 21 have monitors. In our ambulatory area we have six stretcher spaces and three recliner chairs in a room. This facility is the tertiary referral centre for Trauma, Pediatrics, Stroke and Neurology, obstetrics and gynecology services for the island.

RURAL HEALTH SERVICES

- Nootka Area: Gold River Diagnostic & Treatment Centre: no inpatients and 4,000 emergency visits/year
- Tahsis Health Centre: 2,500 emergency visits/year and Zeballos Health Care Centre, both with visiting physician's services and advanced practice nurses at all sites
- Mt. Waddington Area: Port McNeill and Port Hardy Hospitals and Port Alice and Cormorant Island Health Care Centres
- Salt Spring Island/Southern Gulf Islands: Lady Minto Hospital – 8,000 emergency visits/year
- Tofino/Ucluelet Area: Tofino General Hospital 3,700 emergency visits/year



SAANICH PENINSULA HOSPITAL, Saanichton

(23,000 emergency visits/year)

Capacity: 14 stretchers including one trauma room, 12 cardiac monitors, one EENT room, one suture room, one general treatment room, one gynecology room and one casting room.

WEST COAST GENERAL HOSPITAL, Port Alberni

(30,000 emergency & outpatient visits/year)

Capacity: 5 stretcher bays; 1 resuscitation room; 5 monitors; 1 recliner chair; 1 gynecology room; 1 psychiatric assessment/ family support room and 1 cast room.
