At Protection Services, we are dedicated to providing the safest environment possible for our patients, families, visitors, faculty, and staff. We intend to improve upon our successful efforts to create a safe and secure environment using the best technology, resources, and people available, whether it's Protection Services in house security or contract security personnel.

For your safety, Protection Services consist of 100 employees and has the option of 375 Contract security officers who are highly trained and dedicated to the safety of all patients, visitors, and staff members within Vancouver Island Health Authority (VIHA).

WHAT WE DO

Protection Services and contract security responds to over 6250 incidents per month and are available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Some of the types of calls we respond include but are not limited to:

HOW DO I BECOME QUALIFIED

All of our in house Protection Services Officers must be Provincially Licensed to work as a Security Officer in BC and must have successfully completed their Basic Security Training.

Additionally qualified applicants would also need to have successfully completed the Advanced Security Techniques training and be provincially licensed to carry and use handcuffs.
