Replace stabilized chlorine erosion feeder with chlorine injection pump (sodium hypochlorite)	Yes	
Add chemical controller	Yes	
Add pH control pump and acid storage	Yes	
Install new main drain	Yes	
Install in line Flow Meter	Yes	
Install deck drains	Yes	
Replace tiles with non-slip in high traffic areas	Yes	
Provide surface treatment to increase wet friction in low traffic areas	Yes	
Add secondary disinfection to reduce combined chlorine. (UV)	Yes
