<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed by parent and school 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Completed by NSS nurse (with parents input and signature)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parent responsible for sharing child-specific needs with school and schools are responsible to disseminate the information. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NSS responsible for doing delegated training (and monitoring) to two school staff
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Any school staff can follow this plan • All school staff should be familiar with this plan 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • ONLY the school staff who have received delegated care training, and are currently “signed off” for this, can follow the delegated care plan. Delegation is student specific and non-transferable.

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
