



## ImmsBC Orientation for Island Health Long Term Care & Community Health Services Vaccine Providers



ImmsBC is a provincial system for appointment booking, vaccine inventory management and documentation. This document is specific to **Island Health** staff who administer vaccines in **Long Term Care** and **Community Health Services** and who *Create Immunization Record (CIR)* without appointments.

Education materials are provided by Public Health Services Authority (PHSA) & Provincial Public Health Information Systems (PPHIS), with additional guidance from Island Health PPH Information Systems.
