



ImmsBC Education

ImmsBC is a provincial system for appointment booking, vaccine inventory management and documentation.

This document is specific to ***Creating an Immunization Record (CIR) without an appointment***, which is the documentation method used by Long Term Care & Assisted Living vaccine providers.

Education materials are provided by Public Health Services Authority (PHSA) & Provincial Public Health Information Systems (PPHIS), with additional guidance from Island Health PPH Information Systems.

To receive an ImmsBC user account, vaccine providers must complete the self-guided learning below and submit the Island Health education declaration (linked below).
