SUBJECT:	Spring Booster Campaign for COVID-19 in LTC & AL sites: April 8 th – June 30 th 2024

What is happening:

- All eligible Island Health LTC & AL residents should be offered a Spring Booster dose of COVID-19 vaccine starting April 8th, and no later than June 30th, 2024.
- An end date of June 30th, 2024 is required to provide the recommended 3-6 month interval between spring and fall 2024 COVID-19 vaccine doses, and to maximize individual and population level protections against SARS-CoV-2 during the 2024 fall/winter viral respiratory illness season.
- It is required that LTC sites host clinics, and recommended that AL sites host clinics.

Recommended Products & Product Timing:

- COVID-19 Spring booster product is a Monovalent XBB.1.5 50 mcg formulation
- 3 month minimum spacing from a previous dose of COVID-19 vaccine will be permitted, please refer to BCCDC Biologic pages for eligibility criteria.

Vaccine Ordering:

- Sites may begin placing Vaccine Orders April 2nd, 2024.
- Allow 5 business days for your order to be processed and ready for pick up.
- Sites should order their own vaccine. Please indicate whether site staff will be administering immunizations on Vaccine Order. If the answer is no, it will be assumed that a contracted pharmacist is administering vaccine.

Required Documentation & Reporting:

- COVID-19 vaccine must be documented in ImmsBC.
- Each site's Clinic Tally Form provides Public Health with the required information to report to the Ministry of Health.
- Sites must ensure that completed Clinic Tally Form is submitted on the day of the clinic.
