

VIRAL Respiratory Infection (VRI) OUTBREAK In Island Health Long Term Care Affiliate and Private Facilities

OUTBREAK DECLARED OVER

The CD office, in collaboration with the MHO, will declare the viral respiratory illness outbreak over and inform the DOC/Manager/Delegate

STAFF Influenza ☐ Staff may continue to work in the facility including on OB units regardless of vaccine status. MHO may recommend antiviral prophylaxis for unvaccinated staff in a prolonged outbreak. Staff can access antivirals through their own family physician. Staff are not to be excluded from work if they refuse prophylaxis. CD/MHO completes investigation & YES TREATMENT & PROPHYLAXIS – RESIDENTS risk assessment. Influenza: Prepare for oseltamivir prophylaxis as soon as possible after influenza is confirmed. **OUTBREAK** ☐ MHO determines if antiviral prophylaxis of residents is recommended. **DECLARED** ☐ MRP assesses appropriateness & orders prophylaxis for individual residents. COVID: Residents with symptomatic COVID-19 illness to be assessed by their physician for consideration of evidence-based therapy options. **PRECAUTIONS** NO ☐ Pause admissions to outbreak unit, unless authorized by MHO. Inform CD nurse or other designate if there are pending admissions from community who are at intolerable risk or pending admissions from acute care. Apply droplet and contact precautions for confirmed/probable resident cases only (no need to apply to others within the outbreak unit). Implement additional masking measures and restrictions to visitors in accordance with the direction of the MHO. **Apply Individual** Limit congregation of residents: Suspend communal dining (i.e. provide tray service to all residents on the outbreak unit/floor) and group Precautions: activities. ☐ Cohort staff when possible. Reduce ill Inform housekeeping of the need for enhanced cleaning for affected rooms, common areas, and high touch surfaces. residents' contact Verify immunization status of all residents. Offer vaccine to any unvaccinated residents and staff. with others by ☐ Observe all residents of affected unit/floor for symptoms. applying DROPLET & CONTACT precautions, with DIRECTOR OF CARE/MANAGER/DELEGATE tray service. ☐ Activate your communication plan for residents, family, staff, volunteers, and visitors. ☐ Post outbreak signs and alert visitors to go to the nursing station for instructions prior to visiting residents. ☐ Send tracking tools to CD Program (for all VRIs as per policy).
