

Parking at a Cancer Centre

Abbotsford

Abbotsford Regional Hospital & Cancer Centre (ARHCC) - Parking lot & Pass:

Pay parking is available in the ARHCC visitor parking lots. Pay at the machine inside the entry doors. You will need your license plate number. Cost is \$2.50 per hour or portion. You can buy a monthly or weekly parking pass for cancer patients using the senior's rate. Pay at the machine located inside the entry doors. The parking lot is managed by Impark. If you have concerns call their phone number 604-851-4966.

Lutheran church parking lot:

You have to sign a waiver to park here. You can get the waiver at the church reception or BC Cancer volunteer desk on 1st floor. Cost is free. Location is 2029 Ware St. at the Lutheran Church. The church is a ten minute walk to ARHCC. Church phone number is 604-859-5409.

Street parking:

Street parking around the hospital and cancer Centre is for neighborhood residents only.

Kelowna

BC Cancer – Parking lot & Pass

Parking is available at BC Cancer in the front parking lot. You can buy a parking passes from the machine at the front of the building. The machine will give you options for a discount code so you can pay less to park. Patient rates: Daily: \$5.00, Weekly: \$20.00, Monthly: \$53.00.

Kelowna General Hospital (KGH) – Parkade & Pass

You can park at KGH in the main parkade. You can buy parking passes from the machine in the lobby of the clinical academic campus building. Rates: Hourly \$1.50, Daily \$6.00, Weekly \$30.00. Monthly rate of \$53.00. You can buy a monthly pass through Interior Health Parking Services. Call them at 1-855-491-6498.

Street parking

24 hour pay parking is available on the streets immediately surrounding BC Cancer and Kelowna General Hospital. Pay for parking at the meters. This costs \$1.50 per hour. You must pay for parking at BC Cancer or Kelowna General Hospital parking meters. You can park for free for one or two hours on some streets around BC Cancer and Kelowna General Hospital. Please read street signs carefully.

Prince George

Cancer Centre – parking-lot and underground parking:

Pick up a Patient Parking Designation Card at the information kiosk. Put this card on your car dash. You still need to pay for parking at the parking meter. Parking is \$2.00 a day. There is one main parking lot.

Underground parking is beneath the Centre. You need an access card to park in the underground lot. Pick up the card from the information kiosk before your first treatment. Follow the directions as you enter down the left hand lane. Return your access card at the completion of your treatment. There are only 4 access cards.

Street parking:

There is some two hour free street parking near the cancer centre. This parking is monitored by the City of Prince George.

Surrey

Surrey Memorial Hospital (SMH) – parking lot and parkades:

You can park in the SMH parking lot and in the parkades. Parking costs \$4.50 for the first hour and \$3.75 every hour or portion after that. Day rate is \$11.75 (6am-9pm), evening rate is \$5.50 (9pm-6am), 24-hour rate is \$17.25.

Parking pass:

Go to the Chemotherapy Reception (Main level) or Radiation Therapy Reception (1st level) between 8:30am – 4:30pm Monday-Friday. You will receive a "validation code". Then enter the "validation code" to purchase the parking pass at the parking machine. Parking passes are non-refundable; you need to put your parking pass on your car dash.

Vancouver

Cancer Centre parkade:

You can park in the parkade on the corner of West 10th Avenue and Ash Street. Cost is \$3.50 per hour up to a maximum of \$14.25 each day. A booth attendant is available during daytime hours. There are three levels of parking and an elevator is available. Use exact coin or credit card when buying parking between 9:00 pm – 6:00 am Put parking receipt clearly on car dash. The parkade is managed by Metro Parking. Their phone number is 604-909-3929.

Parking pass:

If you are receiving daily radiation treatments, ask your radiation therapist to write a letter of approval for you. Give this letter to the parking attendant. You can buy a four week pass for \$103.25 or a six week pass for \$103.25.

Hardship parking:

If you cannot afford to pay for parking, speak with BC Cancer Patient and Family Counselling Services. Our counsellors can request a hardship parking pass for eligible patients. Call (604) 877-6000 local 672194 for more information.

Street parking:

Metered two hour street parking is available and monitored by the City of Vancouver. Pay attention the time and the street signs.

Parking at City Square Shopping Centre (at the corner of West 12th Avenue and Ash Street):

You can get one hour free parking at City Square Shopping Centre if you spend \$5.00 or more at any of the stores. (Steve Nash Fitness World, Bikram Yoga and Kirin Restaurant give two hours free). Give your parking ticket to the store for validation. You can only validate your ticket once or you will need to pay the maximum daily rate.

Victoria

Cancer Centre – parking lot:

Metered pay parking is available in the lot at the front of the Cancer Centre at \$1.50 an hour. You need to know your parking space number. You can add more time to your parking at the machine at the front entrance. You can use credit cards and cash to pay for parking.

Parking pass:

Weekly parking passes are available for \$26.75 at the Royal Jubilee Hospital (RJH) parking office (room DT1030). This office is near the front entrance of the Diagnostic & Treatment Centre which is across the street from the Cancer Centre on Bay Street. The weekly passes are for parking in Hospital Parking areas only, and not for parking in front of the Cancer Centre.

Hardship parking:

If you cannot afford to pay for parking, speak with BC Cancer Patient and Family Counselling Services. Our counsellors can request a hardship parking pass for eligible patients Call 250-519-5525 for more information.

Street parking:

Limited one hour street parking on Lee Avenue is available and monitored by the City of Victoria.
