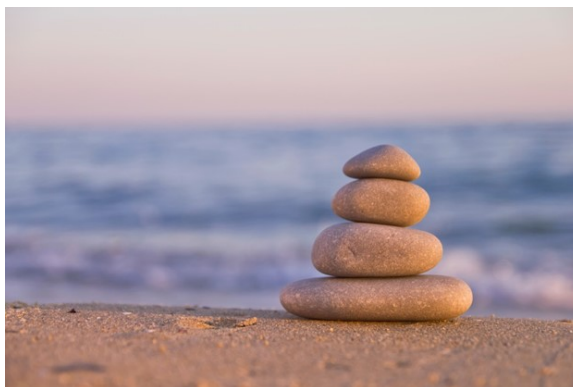

What is the Rapid Access Addiction Clinic?

The Victoria **Rapid Access Addiction Clinic** (RAAC) supports people with problematic opioid use who are ready for treatment with Buprenorphine (Suboxone) or Methadone.

RAAC accepts referrals from community providers, doctors, Island Health's substance use services, hospitals* and client walk ins. Referred RAAC clients are offered booked appointments. Limited walk-in appointments are available from 9am-10am weekdays.

**People who are in the Emergency Department or hospital can get started on Buprenorphine in hospital and be referred to the RAAC or other community services when they leave hospital.*

What Services does the RAAC offer?

RAAC offers:

- Assessment
- Buprenorphine (Suboxone) or Methadone starts and maintenance
- Treatment plan creation, done together with the client
- How to reduce harm to yourself and others
- Take Home Naloxone
- Referrals to social and peer support services
- Supportive transitions to community services and supports
