EVALUATION CRITERIA

<p>ALIGNMENT (10 points)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">To what extent did the project address one or more of Island Health's current goals and research priorities?
<p>EVIDENCE (20 points)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">To what extent did the applicant(s) generate, identify, evaluate, and synthesize high-quality evidence?How well did they apply that evidence to change existing practice or processes?
<p>PLANNING & IMPLEMENTING CHANGE (20 points)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">How well did the applicant(s) plan and implement change based on evidence?To what extent did the applicant(s) identify and overcome challenges or barriers?
<p>AUDIENCE & ENGAGEMENT (10 points)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">Did the applicant(s) identify everyone who needed to be part of the project?How effectively did they engage people to support and implement their change? (e.g. co-workers, decision-makers, patients)If the project involved Indigenous communities, to what extent did the applicant(s) demonstrate meaningful and culturally safe engagement?
<p>MEASUREMENT & IMPACT (20 points)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">To what extent did the applicant(s) show that their use of evidence resulted in improved outcomes, patient and family experience, staff experience or engagement, more effective health service delivery, and/or quality improvement?Did the applicant(s) use effective measures to evaluate that impact?
<p>EQUITY, DIVERSITY, AND INCLUSION (10 points)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">To what extent did the applicant(s) integrate equity, diversity, and inclusion in planning, engaging people in, and implementing their project?
<p>SUSTAINABILITY (10 points)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">To what extent have the applicant(s) planned and/or implemented strategies for sustaining the change?Has the initiative expanded to other areas or departments, or do applicants have plans to do so?
