Please complete the following steps prior to your first BC Virtual Visit appointment:

- 1. Search for the BC Virtual Visit desktop application installed on your Island Health computer
- 2. Login to BC Virtual Visit and check to make sure you have the correct waiting room access

1. Locate the BC Virtual Visit Desktop Application

a) All Island Health computers have the BC Virtual Visit installed. Locate the BC Virtual Visit icon on your desktop
