Virtual Interpreting Services

Virtual Care Services, in partnership with Provincial Language Services (PLS), now offers increased access to professional, medically trained interpreters. Interpreting services are available at no cost to all Island Health programs. With more than 240 languages provided, including American Sign Language (ASL), use of interpreting services improves the quality of patient care.

Key objectives of the launch of the service in the past year were to:


- Deploy the Virtual Remote Interpreting application to all acute care settings via iPads on rolling stands, as well as to care providers working in the community on their Island Health iPhones
- Enable access to the PLS Online Booking Portal, supporting requests for interpreters to join scheduled BC Virtual Visit and Zoom for Healthcare virtual visits with patients
- Increase awareness and utilization of interpreting services at Island Health, including On-Demand Phone Interpreting



Virtual Interpreting Utilization (2022-2023)

From April 1st 2022 to August 31st 2023, there have been 6959 total interpreting requests at Island Health. This breaks down to:

- **4090** Phone Interpreting Requests
- 2725 Virtual Remote Interpreting Requests (Audio and Video)
- 112 Virtual Health Visit Interpreting Requests (Scheduled using PLS Portal)
- 32 In-Person Interpreting Requests (Scheduled using PLS Portal)



Virtual Remote Interpreting

> 123 Virtual Remote Interpreting iPads were deployed to 39 sites across the Island.

PLS Online Booking Portal

> 21 programs now have access to the PLS Online Booking Portal to request scheduled virtual health visit and inperson interpreting.

Overall Interpreting Utilization Increase

➤ There has been a **256%** increase in utilization of interpreting services at Island Health since April 1st, 2022.
