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### Island Health Step Up Youth Scholarship Fund

Island Health is pleased to provide scholarship funding to youth who have participated in the Step Up Youth volunteer program. The Step Up Youth program engages youth ages 15-18 and youth leaders up to age 25 in volunteerism at Island Health facilities.

Up to \$19,000 in scholarship funding is available annually with scholarship awards ranging from \$1500 to \$3500. Successful applicants are only eligible to receive one award in their lifetime.

#### Eligibility Requirements:

In order for an applicant to receive a scholarship award, the applicant must meet the following requirements:

- The applicant must be a youth who has participated in the Step Up Youth volunteer program for at least one cycle (fall through end of April) (the “Volunteer Program”).
- Except as noted below, the applicant must have participated in the Volunteer Program, either as a program participant or a Volunteer Team Leader, in the year of application for the scholarship / award;
  - Volunteer Program participants who are waitlisted for their preferred post-secondary program may defer application for up to one year. Where an applicant defers their application, the application will be considered and judged against the applications in the year the applicant makes the application;
- In the year of application, applicants must have graduated secondary school (grade 12 or equivalent) or be graduating secondary school (grade 12 or equivalent);
- The applicant must intend to pursue a career in healthcare and must be accepted into a program at an accredited post-secondary institution that will assist the applicant in pursuing their career in healthcare (the “University or College Program”);
- The applicant has enrolled in the University or College Program with a program start date between April 1<sup>st</sup> of the year of application to the scholarship award and March 31<sup>st</sup> of the following year.
- Proof of acceptance into the University or College Program must be provided before funds are released and may include:
  - An official letter from the post-secondary institution confirming enrollment; or
  - A voucher provided by Island Health that your post-secondary institution has stamped and signed confirming enrollment.(“Proof of Acceptance”)

#### Application Procedure:

- The application form will be available to Volunteer Program participants no later than Nov 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023;

### *Volunteer Resources & Engagement: Step Up Youth Program*

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- The applicant will complete the application form in full; and
- The application form will include a minimum of three questions requiring long-form answers (no more than 250 words each).

### Selection Procedure:

- Number of hours / years of volunteer service will be considered and scored, with higher numbers of hours producing a higher score;
- Answers to the long-form questions will be considered and scored;
- When two or more submissions receive equal scores, a blind draw will determine the winner;
- When possible, priority will be given to at least one youth who self-identifies as Indigenous;
- When possible, priority will be given to at least one youth who lives in a remote / rural community (regional district population of less than 30,000 individuals); and
- When possible, priority will be given to at least one Step Up Youth Volunteer Team Leader.

### Timeline:

- Applications will be accepted between Nov 30<sup>th</sup>, 2023 and Dec 24<sup>th</sup>, 2023. Applications submitted outside of those dates will not be considered;
- Announcement of scholarship winners will be made no earlier than Dec 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023 and no later than Jan 30<sup>th</sup> 2024;
- The applicant must provide Proof of Acceptance no later than February 10<sup>th</sup> of 2024;
- If no Proof of Acceptance is provided by the deadline, a runner up may be announced as winner between February 11<sup>th</sup> and February 19<sup>th</sup>, with a deadline on or before February 27<sup>th</sup>, 2024 to provide proof of acceptance; and
- All awarded funds will be distributed prior to March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2024.
